### **NSS MERIT CERTIFICATE**

## ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR VOLUNTEERS

The Merit certificate establishes that the National Service Scheme (NSS) Volunteer was active in wide range of activities during his /her tenure. The certificate aims to provide volunteers with the opportunity to gain accreditation for their volunteering activities. It recognizes and acknowledges their contribution to the society in a meaningful and credible manner.

# The Merit certificate will be given to NSS Volunteer only when he/she fulfill the following criteria:-

- 1. Volunteers who have completed two years of Volunteership.
- 2. Who have given minimum 120 hours each year and 240 hours in two years of volunteering in NSS.
- 3. Who have attended one NSS special camping programme for seven days, minimum.
- 4. Who have donated blood at least 2 times particularly male volunteers.
- 5. Female volunteers, who are not eligible/capable to donate blood have to produce certificate from competent authority regarding work done to literate at least five illiterate person of adopted area/slum.
- 6. Who have done the work of plantation.
- 7. Who have done work for the awareness regarding SwachhtaAbhiyaan.
- 8. In the NSS unit of 100 volunteers, 50% will participate in the Seven Day Special Camp.
- 9. Volunteers who have displayed consistent attendance at NSS programme and activities.
- 10. A letter from the Programme Officer and counter signed by Principal with a brief report of the volunteer's contribution and evaluation of their performance.
- 11. Conducted activities in line with the National Service Scheme's mission, vision, goals and contributed to NSS moral.
- 12. Volunteers who raised the profile of voluntary work through NSS and encouraged activity engagement with the local community.
- 13. Volunteer who updated their records periodically.
- 14. Created and strengthened NSS brand awareness, reputation and community relations.
- 15. Volunteers with activity participation in planning and execution, taking up responsibility and being consistent and regular.
- 16. On being satisfied that all requirements as per NSS norms have been met, the Merit certificate can be issued.
- 17. Apart from the above guidelines, NSS volunteers are expected to adhere to the dress code (White upper & Black pant/trousers) during the events.
