Syllabus for Entrance Test of M.A. (Mass Communication), 2024

There will be following three parts of the syllabus:

- 1. **General Knowledge** 45 Marks
- 2. Proficiency Test in Language (English 15 Marks and Hindi 15 Marks) Total -30 Marks
- 3. Communication Skills (English12 Marks and Hindi 13 Marks) Total- 25 Marks

General Knowledge will consist of Indian history, culture, freedom movement, Indian polity and Constitution of India, Geography of India and world, Indian economy, science & technology, agriculture, sports, related miscellaneous aspects, general current awareness and media awareness.

Proficiency Test in Language (English and Hindi) will expect from candidates a good control over the language including spelling, word meaning, synonyms, antonyms, correct one words from many words, etc.

Communication Skills (English and Hindi) will expect from candidates a good control over understanding and comprehension of a variety of communicative passages in both English and Hindi.

Note: Entrance Test comprising of 100 questions of 1 mark each, will be of 1½ hours duration and will consist of multiple choice (objective type) questions with one correct answer. There will be no negative marking for incorrect answer(s). The question paper will have three parts. The first part will cover General Knowledge (45 Marks) which will be common for both English and Hindi students. The second part will cover Proficiency Test in Language in either English or Hindi (30 Marks). The third part will cover Communication Skills (25 Marks) in either English or Hindi.
