Entrance Syllabus (M.Sc. Psychology)

M.Sc. (Psychology) Programme entrance exam will have two sections i.e., Section-A and Section-B. Both the sections will have 50 questions each. In section-A, the 50 questions will be based on subject specific knowledge while Section-B will have questions based on general awareness, reasoning, logical & analytical ability, English language/verbal ability and comprehension.

The entrance exam will comprise of 100 multiple choice questions (Objective type) and will be of one-and-a-half-hour duration. There will be no negative marking. The detailed instruction for attempting the question paper will be given in the test booklet/question paper at the time of entrance.
