

Workshop on Rankings and Accreditations organized for affiliated colleges by IQAC, GJUST, Hisar

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized an online workshop for all the affiliated colleges of GJUST, Hisar on 02.05.2025. The purpose of the workshop was aimed to equip the affiliated institutions with the knowledge, tools, and best practices required to improve their performance in National Institutional Ranking Frameworks and secure favorable accreditation outcomes from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).

Prof. Karampal Narwal, Dean-HSB was the Key Note Speaker for the workshop. Key topics covered during the workshop included the revised NAAC Accreditation process, the significance of the different NAAC criteria (such as curricular aspects, teaching-learning, research, infrastructure, student support, governance, and institutional values etc), and strategies to improve performance in each domain. Special attention was given to data management using tools like the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA), Self-Study Report (SSR), and Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS).

Another highlight of the workshop was on the NIRF ranking methodology, where participants were guided on how to effectively present institutional achievements in terms of teaching, learning, research, graduation outcomes, and outreach. The session also included a demonstration of best practices from top-ranking institutions, providing attendees with actionable insights to implement in their respective colleges

The workshop encouraged interactive participation, allowing representatives from affiliated colleges to share their experiences, challenges, and concerns regarding the accreditation process.

In the concluding session of the said workshop, the Director, IQAC, Prof. Ashish Agarwal urged all affiliated colleges to treat accreditation as an opportunity for institutional transformation. he also told that the IQAC will always be there to assist affiliated colleges in preparing for accreditation and ranking submissions.

The Dy. Director, IQAC Prof. Kashmiri Lal also encouraged interactive participation, allowing representatives from affiliated colleges to share their experiences, challenges, and concerns regarding the accreditation process.
