8. **Considered** and approve the following recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor in its meeting held on 25.04.2017 regarding introduction of Environmental Studies as compulsory subject in all Under Graduate courses from the session 2017-18 (Annexure-VII Page 94 of the agneda):-

1. The University Grants Commission in pursuant to Hon'ble Supreme Court's order dated 06.12.1999 in CWP No. 860/1991 has designed a six months module syllabus for Environmental Studies for Under Graduate courses. Therefore, the said subject be taught in any semester of first year in all the courses at Under Graduate level as per requirement of the respective department and the examination of said course shall be conducted at the end of that semester. As per UGC letter there is no requirement of teaching the said subject in every semester/year.
2. The Environmental Studies course comprising of 45 lecturer+5 practical classes be taught once during the first year of degree in all UG programme as a compulsory subject instead of qualifying subject.
3. The credit of Environmental Studies subject should be same as that of other core subjects.
4. The marks of Environmental Studies subject should be included in the DMC/Degree as in case of other core subjects.
5. Necessary amendments, if any, in this regard be made in the scheme & syllabi of Under Graduate programmes by the respective department in terms of credits.
6. The subject be taught only by qualified subject teachers in terms of UGC.

The Executive Council vide Resolution No. 21 in its 78th meeting held on 16.10.2017 has resolved that the recommendations of the Committee in its meeting held on 18.08.2017 (Appendix-'B' of the EC minutes) be approved with the modifications that this compulsory subject at Under Graduate level be introduced w.e.f. Every University Teaching Departments will explore the possibilities to start atleast one short term course in their respective department.

- (iii) All the mentor Department(s)/Faculty concerned as mentioned at (i) will prepare the complete proposal with course objective/ scope, eligibility criteria, intake, scheme & syllabi, infrastructural and faculty (Teaching/ Non-Teaching) requirements, mode of programmes (Budgeted/ Self-Finance mode) etc. and got approved from their Board of Studies & Research and respective Faculties concerned before placing the same to the Academic Council for its approval.

The Executive Council vide Resolution No. 34 in its 79th meeting held on 03.02.2018 has resolved that the above proposal be approved and started after taking the approval of courses from regulatory bodies, if required.
