Procedure/criteria for preparing merit list

The admissions to B.Sc. B.Ed. (Under ITEP) and B.A. B.Ed. (Under ITEP) programmes will be made on the basis of merit of National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2025 conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) plus weightage(s), if any, as per directions/guidelines of NCTE and/or university, subject to fulfillingthe other conditions as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of theUniversity Prospectus 2025-26. The guidelines of the NCTE will be binding for admissions.

Tie Break Criteria:

If two or more candidates secure identical total score of NCET conducted by NTA (for admission to B.Sc. B.Ed.(under ITEP) and B.A. B.Ed. (ITEP) programme, the merit list will be drawn as under:

- The merit list will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained in aggregate of best five subjects of the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2.
- In case, two or more candidates have secured identical aggregate marks in best five subjects of the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2, the candidate older in age will be preferred.

Important Note:

The candidates who have not appeared in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET-2025) conducted by NTA for admission to Integrated Teacher Education Programme are not eligible to apply for B.Sc. B.Ed.(Under ITEP)-4 Years and B.A. B.Ed. (Under ITEP)-4 Years programmesand the online application forms, if any,submitted by such candidates the same will be stand cancelled and the fee, if any, deposited by them will be forfeited. No separate communication will be made to such candidates.
