The University Library Came into existence in 1996 and is housed in a circular designed three-storey large building. It is named after great Indian Jurist, Economist, Politician and Social Reformer Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar. The library has a collection individual Library Account Status and Availability of books is provided through Web-OPAC. The Library has received 240 printed Indian of 116022 books and 5850 bound volumes of journals. For getting the information about Journals and subscribed 42 magazines and 20 Newspapers. The Library has always been in forefront in the application of latest information and communication technology, whenever available. To make it accomplish, the Library in its electronic repository, has the access to 8000+ e-journals from 12 publishers and 5 Databases. In addition, 18310 video Lectures of IITs through National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning are also accessible over Campus Wide Network. Moreover, 2149 e-books of national and international reputed publishers have also been added in e-repository to enrich the students.
