(II) Postgraduate Programmes

i) MBA (Health Care)

The BOS&R in Haryana School of Business, vide resolution no. 3 in its meeting held on 31.05.2023, has approved the proposal for introduction of new specialization in MBA-Health Care w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 and further recommended for its consideration and approval of the Academic Council and Executive Council. ii) M.Sc. Computer Science (Artificial Intelligence and Data Science)

(Computer Science) (Artificial Intelligence and Data Science) two years (four semester) with an intake of 40 seats w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 and further recommended for its consideration and approval of the Academic Council and Executive Council **(Annexure-IV Pages 14-19 of the agenda).**

iii) M.Sc. (Botany)

(Botany) with an intake of 30 seats w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 and further recommended for its consideration and approval of the Academic Council and Executive Council **(Annexure-V Pages 20-23 of the agenda).**

iv) M.Sc. (Zoology)

The Dean, Faculty of Environmental and Bio Sciences & Technology will mentor the programme of M.Sc. (Zoology).

v) M.A. Education

The M.A. Education programme was approved by the Academic Council vide resolution No. 49 in its meeting held on 19.03.2021. The Executive Council has also approved the above said programme vide resolution No. 34 in its meeting held on 06.12.2021. The requirement for creation of posts for above said programme has been forwarded to the State Govt. by the Faculty Branch.

vi) Any other Postgraduate Programme

Resolved that the above proposal be approved for introduction of all Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes as per National Education Policy-2020 w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 in Budgeted mode and be recommended to the Executive Council for consideration and approval for onward submission to State Govt. for creation of posts.

Resolved that the above proposal for change of nomenclature of the existing Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. programmes in Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics to Integrated B.Sc. (Honours/Honours with Research)-M.Sc. programmes as per new National Education Policy 2020 w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 be approved. It was also resolved that the nomenclature of Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. Biotechnology be changed to Integrated B.Sc. (Life Sciences) -M.Sc. Biotechnology/ Microbiology/Botany/ Zoology programme:-

It was also resolved that the scheme of examinations and syllabi of all above programmes as well as the award of Certificate/ Diploma/ Degree be prepared within one month by the respective Board of Studies & Research as per template of Curricula and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes National Credit Framework (NCrF) and National Higher Education Qualification Framework (NHEQF) of UGC under National Education Policy-2020.

Further, the House authorized the Vice-Chancellor for approving the minor changes/ amendments in the above said proposal.

Further, resolved that the requirement of teaching posts for existing programmes where National Education Policy-2020 is being implemented be converted in the ratio of 1 : 2: 4 for 2 Years PG programme, 1 : 3: 7 for 4 Years UG programme and 2 : 4 : 8 for 5 Years Integrated programme for Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor respectively and the requirement of non-teaching staff be also approved as Assistant- (01), Clerk- (01) and Peon- (01) for each one. Accordingly the list be updated and be forwarded to the State Govt. for creation of teaching and non-teaching posts.

- ii) The BOS&R in Communication Management & Technology, vide resolution no. 01 in its online urgent meeting held 06.06.2023 has recommended that the nomenclature of the existing B.A. (Mass Communication) four year programme be changed to B.A. (Honours/Honours with Research) in Mass Communication w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 for implementation of National Education Policy-2020.
- iii) Any other agenda item regarding change in nomenclature of existing Undergraduate Programmes w.e.f. academic session 2023-24.

Resolved that the above proposal be approved. It was also resolved that the nomenclature of existing B.Sc. (Hons.)-Economics and B.Sc. (Hons.)-Psychology be also changed w.e.f. academic session 2023-24 as per National Education Policy-2020.

It was also resolved that the scheme of examinations and syllabi of all above programmes as well as award of Certificate/ Diploma/ Degree be prepared within one month by the respective Board of Studies & Research as per template of Curricula and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes National Credit Framework (NCrF) and National Higher Education Qualification Framework (NHEQF) of UGC under National Education Policy-2020.

Further, the House authorized the Vice-Chancellor for approving the minor changes/ amendments in the above said proposal.

Further, the House recommended the above decision to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.
