Similarly, the option will be allowed to the students of batch 2022-23.
- (ii) The students who want to pursue 4th year of B.A. (Mass Communication) will be given B.A. (Hons.) Mass Communication Degree after successfully completion of 4 years/ 8 semesters.
- (iii) The students of Batches 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24, who will specially complete their B.A. (Hons.) Mass Communication 4 Years/ 8 semesters, they will be allowed to pursue M.A. (Mass Communication) (one year programme).
- (iv) The Detailed Marks Cards (DMC's) and or Degrees of above said programme will be designed and prepared accordingly by the examination branch.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor as above be noted and ratified.
