In the B.A. English (Hons), a student is supposed to pass 26 subjects in total. Out of this, a student has to study the subjects in the following manner:

1. Sixteen English language papers i.e. (Two in 1<sup>st</sup> Sem, Two in 2<sup>nd</sup> SEM, Three in 3<sup>rd</sup> Sem, Three in 4<sup>th</sup> Sem, Three in 5<sup>th</sup> Sem, and Three in 6<sup>th</sup> Sem.).
2. Two papers of other language i.e. Hindi (One Hindi Compulsory in 1<sup>st</sup> Sem and Second Hindi Compulsory in 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem)
3. Two compulsory papers (one i.e. computer awareness in 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters and second i.e. Environmental awareness in 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester)
4. Six subsidiary papers– a student is to opt for one subsidiary paper in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester out of the list provided and continue opting for the same paper up to sixth semester (one paper once opted for in 1<sup>st</sup> semester, will continue upto 6<sup>th</sup> Semester)
