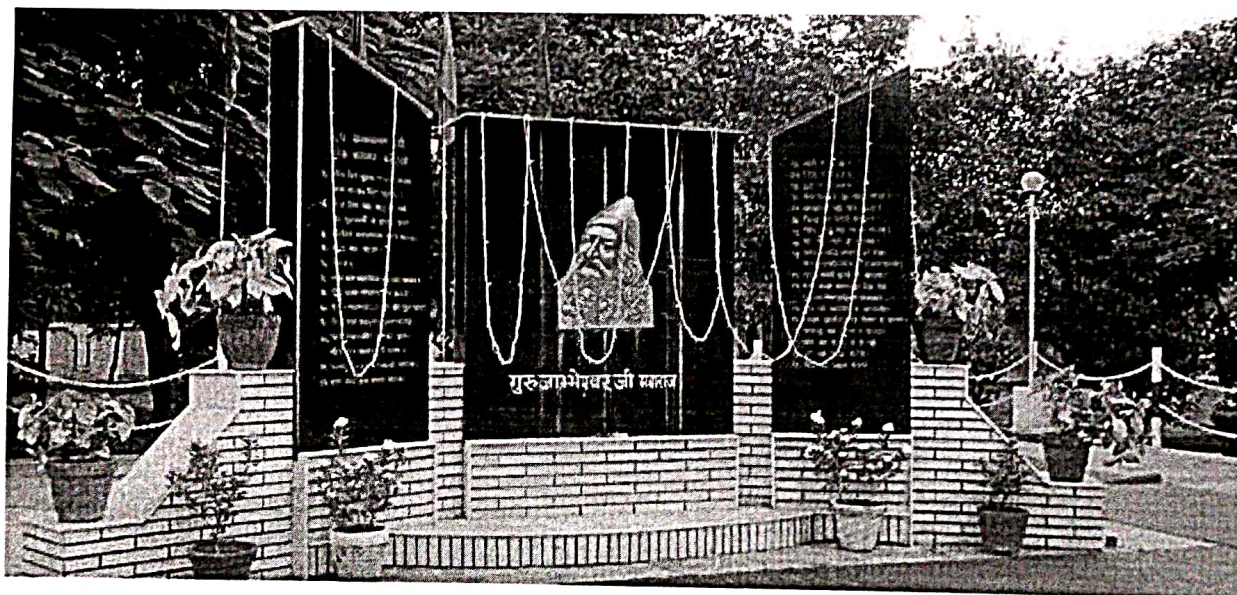

## ABOUT PROGRAMMES

M.A. Mass Communication (2025-26) (One Year) programme is meant for students who have completed a B.A. Mass Communication (four year degree) under NEP-2020. This programme shall be of one year/ two semesters duration. The syllabus of this M.A. Mass Communication (One year) (2025-26) programme shall be the same as the syllabus of the second year (Semesters 3 and 4) of the existing two year M.A. Mass Communication Programme.

## ELIGIBILITY

B.A. (Mass Communication)-4 years programme under NEP-2020 from a recognized College, Institution or University.

## MODE OF INVITING APPLICATIONS/ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Applicants for M.A. Mass Communication (One year) need to fill their application forms Online. The admission notice seeking applications from interested candidates shall be displayed on the University website [www.gjust.ac.in](http://www.gjust.ac.in)

A merit list shall be drawn for admission on the basis of the academic merit (marks obtained in the qualifying examination) and also the weightage of Sports/NSS, if any.

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELING/REPORTING:

All the original documents are required as per Clause 6.1 of the University Prospectus 2025-26. The result of qualifying examination i.e. B.A. Mass Communication (Four

year programme) is mandatory for admission to M.A. Mass Communication (One year programme). On ascertaining the eligibility, the Admission Committee will allot a seat as per merit/ preference subject to availability of seat.


The Committee will issue admission slip, on the basis of which the candidate will have to deposit fees on the spot. Candidates are therefore advised to bring the required amount (See Chapter-8 on "Fee Structure 2024-25" amounting to Rs. 28200/- for depositing the fees at the time of counseling failing which their admission shall stand forfeited. If a candidate does not deposit the fees after the issue of admission letter, she/he may be allowed to participate in the subsequent counseling's as fresh candidate. However, if a candidate after depositing the fees wants to shift from one programme to the other, she/he will be allowed to do so in the subsequent counseling as per merit subject to her/his eligibility and availability of seat(s).


