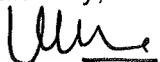

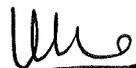

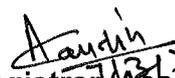

At the very outset, Prof. Narsi Ram Bishnoi, Vice-Chancellor and Chairperson of the Executive Council, welcomed all the members who attended the meeting in online mode namely Prof. Som Nath Sachdeva, Vice-Chancellor, KUK, Sh. Sumer Singh Yadav, Deputy Secretary, nominee of Finance Department, Sh. K. P. Singh, Addl. Director, Technical Education, nominee of ACS Technical Education, Haryana, and all the members present in offline mode in 103rd meeting of the Executive Council.

The Vice-Chancellor appraised to the House about the major achievements of the Guru Jambheshwar University of Science and Technology, Hisar as under:

1. Recently, the University has achieved the following ranks/position in NIRF India Rankings-2025:-
 - Ranked 32nd in the 'State Public University' Category.
 - Ranked 49th in 'Pharmacy' Category.
 - Rank Band 101-125 in the 'Management' Category.
 - Rank Band 101-150 in the 'University' Category.
 - Rank Band 151-200 in the 'Overall' Category.
 - Rank Band 201-300 in the 'Engineering' Category.
 - Rank Band 11-50 in the 'Sustainable Development Goals' Category
2. Rank Band 1001-1100 in the QS World University Rankings : Asia 2026.
3. Rank Band 1201-1500 in the world and Ranked 73rd in India in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings-2026.
4. This University has also been honored to be part of the Global Initiative of Academic Networks (GIAN) Phase-V, a prestigious academic scheme of the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India.
5. Scopus Research Publication of Guru Jambheshwar University of Science and Technology, Hisar is 5670 with Institution h-index 138, which is highest in Haryana and citations is 1,27,333 with average paper citations 22.45, which is highest in the State.

The University has also started new programme i.e. B.Sc. Nursing (4 years programme) and Post Basic B.Sc. 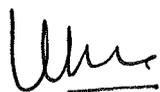
