



### NOTIFICATION

The Vice Chancellor, on the recommendations of a Committee under the Chairmanship of the Dean Academic Affairs in its meeting held on 27.08.2025, has approved the following amendment(s) in eligibility criteria for admission in Integrated B.Sc. (Physical Sciences)-M.Sc. Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics programmes (where seats are still lying vacant) and also approved the provision(s) for the candidates having the re-appear in only one paper either in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> semester at undergraduate level other than the subject in which he/she is interested to seek admission in Postgraduate Programmes (where seats are also still lying vacant) of two years duration (except Engineering, Management, Physiotherapy and Pharmaceutical Programmes) for the academic session 2025-26 subject to the condition mentioned in this notification and approved the addition of procedure/criteria in case of fresh candidates for seeking admission to said Postgraduate Programmes (where seats are still lying vacant) in the ongoing Physical Counseling(s) scheduled to be held on 29.08.2025 in the respective departments:-

1. The eligibility condition for admission in Integrated B.Sc. (Physical Sciences)-M.Sc. Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics will be as under:-

The candidate(s) should have passed 10+2 examinations in science discipline with at least 50% marks in 10+2 examinations from a recognized Board/University. The candidate(s) should have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in 10+2 examinations. The candidates who have appeared with subject combinations of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) will also be allowed to seek admission in Integrated B.Sc. (Physical Sciences)-M.Sc. (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) subjects, provided they have studied both Mathematics and Biology at the 10+2 level.

2. The candidates having reappear in only one paper either in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> semester at undergraduate level other than the subject in which he/she is interested to seek admission in Postgraduate programme (where seats are still lying vacant) of two-year duration (except Engineering, Management, Physiotherapy and Pharmaceutical Programmes) will be allowed for admission in Postgraduate programme(s) for the academic session 2025-26 only subject to the condition that they will have to pass their concerned re-appear paper of 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> semester of graduation before the promotion to 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of the concerned PG Programme. If they fail to pass the concerned one reappear paper of their 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> semester of graduation, their provisional admission in the PG Programme will be cancelled ab-initio and the fee deposited by them will be forfeited. An undertaking (**Annexure-I**) from such students to this effect must be taken prior to their admission in the Department.



3. The admission to the fresh candidates will be made on the basis of academic merit plus weightage, if any, as per criteria given in the University Prospectus 2025-26 and in addition to procedure/criteria mentioned in the University Prospectus 2025-26, the following procedure/criteria may be followed:

- i. The students who have passed their qualifying examination will be considered for admission first.
- ii. Thereafter, those candidate(s) will be considered whose complete result of the qualifying examination are not declared till the date of the counseling and the result of first (n-1) semesters/years is available.
- iii. In last, for remaining vacant seats, if any, reappear candidate(s) will be considered and for preparing merit list of such candidates, minimum passing marks may be counted in reappear paper.
