The following agenda's items were discussed and approved accordingly:-

1. Out of Six MoU, there are only five MoU's for Innovative Proposals submitted by the following Innovators which were discussed in detail by the Committee members with relevant suggestions incorporated along with suggestion of Legal Officer of the University.
 - i) Dr. Rishi Pal from M/s DeepLeads Innovation Pvt. Ltd, Maharashtra with GJUS&T, Hisar
 - ii) Mr Sandeep Kumar from M/s Preluex Solution, Hisar with GJUS&T, Hisar
 - iii) Mr Vishal Gupta from M/s ACTFUSE, Kanpur with GJUS&T, Hisar has requested that three of Engineers will be stationed at M/s ACTFUSE, Noida Office.
 - iv) Mr. Sashi Sairaman from M/s MTAB Technology Center, Chennai with GJUS&T, Hisar
 - v) Mr Suneel Verma, Assistant Prof. (Mentor) from M/s Promoter of Bug2Debug Pvt Ltd, Hisar for Young Innovators Mr Kartikey Choudhary (Roll No. 16013004), Mr Kuldeep, Roll No. 16013024, Mr Hiten Jain, Roll No. 16013005, Mr Rana Atul Roll No. 16013046, Mr Vishnu Bahadur, Roll No. 1601010139009 with GJUS&T, Hisar
 - vi) Mr Vikram Singh from M/s Beam InfoTech Pvt Ltd, Gurugram with GJUS&T, Hisar.



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The Steering Committee considered the request of Mr Vishal Gupta, M/s ACTFUSE, Noida to station three of his Engineers in Noida Office and one Engineer will work full time at PDUIC, GJUS&T, Hisar. They will use the facility of Hardware and Software at M/s ACTFUSE, Noida Office and will not purchase any equipment approved by the Steering Committee for the Startup project of Rs. 4,00,000/-. The Engineer appointed at PDUIC, GJUS&T, Hisar will be selected by M/s ACTFUSE, Hisar in consultation with GJUS&T and a candidate at B.Tech/M./Tech level will be hired for the Startup project who has passed from GJUS&T, Hisar. Furthermore, Mr Vishal Gupta/other team members will visit PDUIC, GJUS&T, Hisar as and when required. Likewise one engineer station at PDUIC, GJUS&T, Hisar for the Startup project will be visiting M/s ACTFUSE, Noida Office as and when required for the completion of Startup project. This will be the part of MoU to be signed.

The Steering Committee recommended that the final document of Five MoUs be vetted by the respective Innovators and signing of MoU be done after seeking suitable date from the Vice-Chancellor/Registrar. The sixth MoU submitted Mr Vikram Singh from M/s Beam InfoTech Pvt Ltd, Gurugram with GJUS&T, Hisar be closed based on his request.

2. The Steering Committee considered the progress reports submitted by following Young Innovators in PDUIC through their respective Mentors given below:-

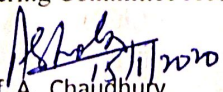

Estimated budget and Layout of Computer Lab, 2 Cabins with Aluminum Glass partition, Vinyl flooring, Vanishing Blinds, Split Air Conditioners has been received from Construction branch of the University.

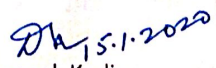
The Steering Committee recommends renovation and installation of the above items in the Workshop Hall for the Office of Director, PDUIC from the budget head PDUIC-ICT Infrastructure 2019-20 and all the purchases and work will be carried out by Executive Engineer University Works Department.


4. The Steering Committee recommends the purchase of Fifty five Computers (Desktop), two lap tops for PDUIC and fifty computer tables (work stations) and fifty chairs of Godrej make similar to the ones purchased for PDUCIC recently.
5. The Steering Committee recommends the purchase of one Photocopy machine which is urgently required for day to day official work in PDUIC from the budget head PDUIC. The expenses will be met out from the budget head PDUIC-Contingency RUSA 2.0.
6. The Steering Committee recommends providing the installation of Wi-Fi Internet facility for the Computer Lab with 55 Computers in the Workshop Hall of PDUIC. The case may be forwarded to CWN for necessary action. The expenses will be met out from the budget head PDUIC-ICT Infrastructure 2019-20.
7. The Steering Committee discussed the research project proposal submitted by Dr. David Joseph, Assistant Professor, Deptt of Physics, GJUS&T, Hisar. It was observed that it is of a routine nature, nothing novel and lacks Innovation with no product development. Therefore, the Steering Committee rejects the research proposal.

11. The Steering Committee considered and approved the request of Mr Mohit, Young Innovator in the Innovative Proposal entitled "**Crime Investigation management Tool**" for the following items:-

 - d) A Biometric Kit. Recommended for purchase.

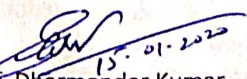

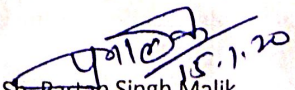

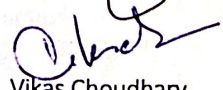
