



NOTIFICATION

The Vice Chancellor, on the recommendations of a Committee under the Chairmanship of the Dean Academic Affairs in its meetings held on 29.10.2024, 10.01.2025, 16.01.2025, 23.04.2025 and 24.04.2025, is pleased to approve the following "Rules for Additional Subjects to the pass out students of Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. Physics, Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. Chemistry, Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. Mathematics and Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. Biotechnology" course w.e.f. batch 2016 onwards in the University under Section 11(5) of University Act, 1995 in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council and the Executive Council:

1. The students who had completed their Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. programmes (in Physics/ Chemistry/ Mathematics/ Biotechnology) w.e.f. batch 2016 onwards from this University will be offered the additional subjects in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Botany and Zoology for the purpose of their eligibility for the post of Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) in State/ Central Government. These additional subjects will be offered to all existing and pass out students w.e.f. batch 2016 onwards.
2. The Scheme of examinations and syllabi for the additional subject(s) duly approved by statutory bodies of the University will be applicable. Passing percentage of marks for additional subjects shall be same as applicable in the Scheme of examinations of respective Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. programme(s)/ University Ordinance. Scheme of Additional subjects/papers to be studied by students will be uploaded on the University website by the Department concerned.
3. The theory classes of the additional subject concerned will be offered through Offline/ Online mode, whereas the practical classes of the additional subjects will be conducted through Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) on working days/ Saturday/ Sunday/ Holiday to be decided by the department concerned in consultation with Dean of Faculty concerned.
4. The duration of the additional subject/paper will be of 06/12 months for the students who have passed the Dual Degree/Integrated B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. programmes in (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) and 12/18 months for the students who had passed Dual Degree/Integrated B.Sc. (Hons.)-M.Sc. programmes in Biotechnology. In any case, student will not study more than 24 credits per semester (6 month).
5. The fee for the additional subject/ course will be Rs. 5000/-(lumpsum) for six months including examination fee.
6. The examinations will be conducted by the Department concerned like the examinations of course work of Ph.D. programme of the University in consultation with Dean of the Faculty concerned and Controller of Examinations.

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7. No remuneration will be paid to the teacher(s) for conduct of theory as well as practical classes and conduct of examination of additional subjects also.
8. No separate degree certificate will be issued for the additional subjects in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biotechnology/ Botany/ Zoology. Only the Detailed Marks Card (DMC) of additional subject(s) examinations shall be issued separately by the examination branch of the University.
9. The candidate(s)/ student(s) who will not clear the examinations of additional subjects within the time frame/ chances, will have to apply afresh. No extra/mercy chance will be given to such candidates.
10. The candidate(s)/ student(s) shall not be required to submit the Migration Certificate in the University for additional subject(s) examinations.
11. The Committee also recommends that in addition to the above said rules, "Rules for Additional Subjects at Graduation Level in case of Non-practical papers to the pass out students already notified by the University vide Notification dated 18.04.2023 will also be applicable.
12. Any other rules/ instructions/ guidelines issued by the University authorities from time to time will also be applicable in this regard.


