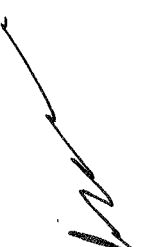

- As per existing 20% quota reserved for Scheduled Castes in Haryana, one-half of the seats are reserved for candidates of Deprived Scheduled Castes (DSC) and one-half of the seats are reserved for Other Scheduled Castes (OSC) and if on a particular occasion, the total no. of seats meant for Scheduled Castes is Odd number, then the number of seats shown for Other Scheduled Castes (OSC) and Deprived SC candidates, as per their quantum of reservation notified by the Haryana Government vide letter dated 04th June, 2020 and letter dated 13th November, 2024 are not equal in the seat matrix for the session 2025-26 in a particular programme, then it will be inter-changed in next academic session (i.e. 2026-27) on rotation basis, if total no. of seats remain the same.
 - In case of M. Tech. Programmes, one seat in each discipline cannot be given for PH/Differently-abled Persons due to fractional part of said category, this year i.e.(2025-26) one seat is available each in M. Tech. (CSE), M. Tech. (Environmental Sc. & Engineering) and M. Tech. (Printing Technology) and next year (i.e. 2026-27), it will be available to other disciplines of M.Tech. programmes, if the total no. of seats remain the same.
 - For the session 2025-26, the fraction point of 2.72 no. of seats, in case of BCA category in M. Tech. (Env. Sc. & Engg.) has been taken as 2 seats and the fraction point of 1.87 no. of seats in case of BCB category in M. Tech. (Printing Technology) has been taken as 01 seat, so that total number of seats under BCA and BCB categories may not exceed the percentage of reservation for BCA and BCB categories respectively in all programmes.

- One seat in each UGC Programme is allowed as Supernumerary seat for North-Eastern candidate/ ward of deceased due to COVID-19 of Haryana.
- One supernumerary seat in each UGC programme is allowed as supernumerary seat for the children (son/daughter) of permanent University employees (Teaching and Non-Teaching) of GJUS&T, Hisar.
- One seat is allowed as Supernumerary seat for Kashmiri Migrants in UGC Programmes.
- Upto 25% seats of the sectioned intake in each UGC programme are allowed as Supernumerary for Foreign Nationals.
- 30 seats in M.Sc. (Biotechnology) are DBT Supported and will be filled through Graduate Aptitude Test-Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2025.
- One supernumerary seat each in M.Sc. (Psychology), M.A. (Mass Communication) and M.Sc. (Economics) is allowed for Defence Persons in service.

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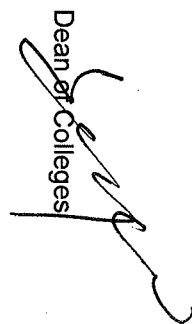

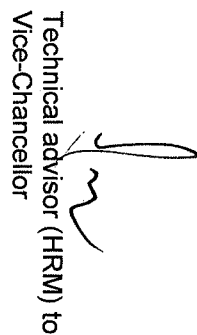
- i) The distribution of seats is applicable programme-wise only.
- ii) Scholarship will be awarded to those students of M.Pharma / M.Tech., who have Valid qualified GPAT/ GATE examination at the time of admission subject to receipt of the same from AICTE or any other regulatory bodies. The non-GPAT/Non-GATE students, if any, admitted in M.Pharma./ M.Tech. programmes on the basis of academic merit of qualifying examination/ Entrance Test, will not be eligible for scholarship.
- iii) As per existing 20% quota reserved for Scheduled Castes in Haryana, one-half of the seats are reserved for candidates of Deprived Scheduled Castes (DSC) and one-half of the seats are reserved for Other Scheduled Castes (OSC) and if on a particular occasion, the total no. of seats meant for Scheduled Castes is Odd number, then the number of seats shown for Other Scheduled Castes (OSC) and Deprived SC candidates, as per their quantum of reservation notified by the Haryana Government vide letter dated 04th June, 2020 and letter dated 13th November, 2024 are not equal in the seat matrix for the session 2025-26 in a particular programme, then it will be inter-changed in next academic session (i.e. 2026-27) on rotation basis, if total no. of seats remain the same.
- iv) Normally, if the number of calculated seats as per existing Reservation Policy of the State Government in a particular category is not in a round figure, its fractional part below 0.5 has been ignored and the fractional part 0.5 or above will be taken as one provided that total number of seats under all categories in a programme/ course / specialization will not exceed the sanctioned intake. The fraction below 0.5 has been given seat (i.e. full seat) and the fraction 0.5 and above has been given zero seat (i.e. ignored) in some programmes to ensure that all categories have been got their representation on overall total number of seats. In case of M.Pharm. and Master of Physiotherapy where one seat is provided for "differently-abled person" on rotation basis, it cannot be applied, so total number of seats remain unchanged.
- v) The Committee considered the clarification of Director, Higher Education Haryana vide Memo. No. KW/30/3-2019 Co(2) dated 07.06.2019 and 24.06.2019 in respect of reservation of Economically Weaker Section in Admissions that 10% reservation for Economical Weaker Section(EWS) will be 50% of the State Quota and will be 42.5% of the total intake (i.e. 50% of General Category out of 85% of Haryana domicile). The above said clarification was given by the Director Higher Education Haryana, Panchkula in reference to instructions issued vide letter No. vide No. 22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 25.02.2019 of Govt. of Haryana, General Administration Department. Accordingly, the Committee calculated 10% seats for EWS out of remaining seats of Haryana Open General Category (HOGC).
- vi) The seats still remaining vacant of Other Schedule Caste and Deprived Schedule Caste after the second counseling, will again be offered to the candidate(s) of Other Schedule Caste and Deprived Schedule Caste respectively at the start of third counseling. If some seats of Other Scheduled Caste and Deprived Scheduled Caste still remain vacant/ unfilled upto 2.00 p.m. in the third counseling, these will be filled from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. by drawing combined merit list of the candidates belonging to Other Scheduled Caste and Deprived Scheduled Caste. If the seats still remain vacant, these will be converted into Haryana Open General Category (HOGC) and filled accordingly at 4.00 p.m.
- vii) The University has adopted the clarification given by Haryana Government, Chief Secretary Organization, Human Resource Department, vide their letter No. 22/163/2024-5 HR-III dated Chandigarh, the 13th November, 2024 for the purpose of admission for the academic session 2025-26 (copy enclosed).

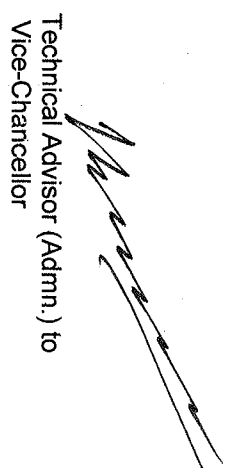
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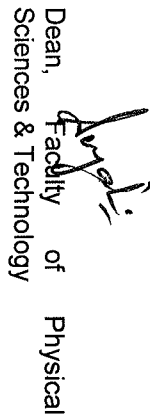

Subject : Classification of Scheduled Castes for the purpose of benefit of reservation in Haryana State.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Government Instructions issued vide No. 22/10/2013-1GS-III, dated 15.07.2014 and thereafter regarding rate(s) of reservation in Govt. jobs and to say that in compliance of the judgement dated 01.08.2024 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case titled "State of Punjab v/s Davinder Singh (CA No. 2317 of 2011) with regard to sub-classification and adequacy of representation, the matter was referred to the Haryana State Commission for Scheduled Castes for examination and to send their recommendations to address intra-community disparities and to ensure a fair and equitable distribution of reservation benefits. The Commission submitted their report on 16th August, 2024 prepared on the basis of analysis of the data received from various sources including different Departments and of the demands, representations and review of literature related to the subject. The recommendations of the Commission regarding classification of Scheduled Castes reservation in Govt. jobs were considered by the State Government. After the approval of Council of Ministers, it has been decided that—

- (i) For the purpose of reservation in services, the Scheduled Castes in Haryana will be sub-categorized in two categories i.e. Deprived Scheduled Castes (DSC) and Other Scheduled Castes (OSC).
- (ii) List of Deprived Scheduled Castes and Other Scheduled Castes has been enclosed at **Annexure-A** of these instructions.
- (iii) Within the existing 20% quota reserved for Scheduled Castes in direct recruitment to Govt. jobs, one-half of the posts will be reserved for candidates of Deprived Scheduled Castes. If and only if suitable candidates of Deprived Scheduled Castes are not available, then suitable candidates of Other Scheduled Castes may be recruited against the balance vacant posts.
- (iv) Similarly, one-half of the quota reserved for Scheduled Castes shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Other Scheduled Castes. If and only if suitable candidates of Other Scheduled Castes are not available, then suitable candidates of Deprived Scheduled Castes may be recruited against the balance vacant posts.
- (v) The combined merit list of the candidates belonging to Deprived Scheduled Castes and Other Scheduled Castes selected/recommended by the Recruiting Agency will

be prepared and inter-se seniority of such candidates will also be fixed on the basis of merit.

- (vi) It will not be necessary to fix the roster points separately for each of the sub-categories within the present roster system.
- (vii) If on a particular occasion the total number of vacant posts (cadre wise) meant for Scheduled Castes is odd, say 9, then 5 of them will go to Deprived Scheduled Castes and 4 posts to Other Scheduled Castes. On the next such occasion, however, the position would be reversed, i.e. 4 of them will go to Deprived Scheduled Castes and 5 posts to Other Scheduled Castes.
- (viii) After the issue of these instructions, the first vacant post reserved for Scheduled Castes will be allocated to Deprived Scheduled Castes without any change in the roster point already maintained by the Department.

2. These instructions will be applicable with immediate effect and Annexure-B of instructions bearing No. 22/10/2013-1GS-III, dated 15.07.2014 in which the list of castes which are to be treated as Scheduled Castes in Haryana State has been specified for the purpose of reservation in jobs under Government/Government Undertakings and Local Bodies as well as for admission in Government/Government aided educational/technical professional institutions, will be deemed to have been replaced with the Annexure-A of these instructions.

3. These instructions may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
