The course is designed to make the students achieve beginner's level proficiency in German language (equivalent to A1 level of Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)). After successful completion of the course, the students are expected to understand and use familiar, everyday expressions and very simple sentences in German, which relate to the satisfying of concrete needs. The students can introduce themselves and others as well as ask others about themselves – e.g. where they live, who they know and what they own – and can respond to questions of this nature. They can also communicate in a simple manner if the person they are speaking to speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to help.

Course Objectives:

The Short-Term Certificate course is aimed at students who wish to learn German from the beginning. The objectives of the course are to make the students:

- Understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at he satisfaction of needs of a concrete type.
- Introduce themselves and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people they know and things they have.
- Interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

Course Outcomes:

By the end of this course, the students are expected to attain the beginner's level proficiency in German language equivalent to CEFR A1 level (breakthrough), and to be ready for taking DELF A1 Certification.
