

The Vice-Chancellor, on the request of the candidates and the Chairperson, Department of Printing Technology and Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering has allowed to invite On-line Application Forms for admission to M.Tech. (Printing Technology) and M.Tech. (Electronics and Communication Engineering) regular programmes with an intake of 20 seats each run by the University for the academic session 2024-25. Note:- If the number of seats shown for SC and Deprived SC candidates, as per their quantum of reservation notified by the Haryana Government vide letter dated 04th June, 2020 are not equal in the seat matrix in a particular programme, then it will be inter-changed in next academic session i.e. 2025-26.

In case of M.Tech. Programmes, one seat in each discipline cannot be given for PH/Differently-abled Persons due to fractional part of said category, this year i.e. (2024-25) one seat is available each in M.Tech. (ECE) and next year (i.e. 2025-26), it will be available to other M.Tech. disciplines.

For the session 2024-25, the fraction point 2.72 in case of BCA category in M.Tech. (ECE) has been taken as 02, so that total number of seats under BCA category may not exceed the percentage of reservation for BCA category in all programmes.
